“Our courses have participated in the previous two Patriot Golf Day events but this year, we wanted to do a little more to help the families of our brave American soldiers,” said Mike Buccerone of Grande Dunes. “One of our PGA golf professionals participating came up with this great idea to raise additional contributions and we hope that the entire Myrtle Beach community will call and make their pledges to benefit Patriot Golf Day.”

From Friday, September 4 through Monday, September 7, golfers across the United States will be asked to donate a minimum of \$1 in support of Patriot Golf Day, with all proceeds benefitting the Folds of Honor Foundation, an organization that provides scholarship opportunities to the families of soldiers who have been injured or killed in the line of military duty. Patriot Golf Day events range in organization from a simple \$1 addition to greens fees all the way to Patriot Golf Day tournaments and clinics. In 2008, 3,800 golf facilities nationwide participated in Patriot Golf Day, raising more than \$2 million.

Sponsored by the PGA of America and the USGA, Patriot Golf Day was started in 2007 by Captain Dan Rooney, after he'd finished his second tour of duty in Iraq, An F-16 pilot for the 125th Fighter Squadron of the Oklahoma Air National Guard, and a PGA professional, Rooney recognized the tremendous need to provide support to the families of his comrades, killed and injured.
