Master Association Minute

Grande Dunes Trolley: The Grande Dunes trolley will resume its seasonal runs between Marina Park and the Ocean Club on Friday, May 26, 2023. From Thursday through Monday each week, the trolley will pick up Grande Dunes' guests from a bench near Anchor Cafe and drop them off at the entrance to the Ocean Club's pool tunnel. Service will start at 11:00 a.m. and end at 5:00 p.m. every day, with the trolley arriving at each location on a continuous 30-minute loop. A QR code posted near each stop will continue to provide real-time location updates for riders via a link to a custom GPS app. Note that no trolley service will be offered on Tuesdays or Wednesdays, and operations will stop for the summer on Labor Day.

Volunteers Needed: The Grande Dunes Master Association is seeking six to ten willing residents to help with upcoming homeowner events. Tasks may vary depending on the event, but will typically only last about an hour and include assisting with check in, handing out items and helping to direct guests. Members Dive In to the Season at Grande Dunes Pool

The early onset of warmer weather this year has made many members of the Grande Dunes community excited for a swim. Their desire for a dip was finally quenched on Friday, March 31, 2023 when the Ocean Club pool deck officially opened for the season. Though access was limited to weekends only in April, the Ocean Club pool deck is now ready to receive residents and guests seven days a week from 10:00 a.m. through 6:00 p.m.. Featuring a kids' splash pad, heated swimming pool and whirlpool, the Ocean Club pool deck also offers cabana rentals, casual outdoor dining and a host of drink options. The pool bar and grill are both open for service daily starting at 11:00 a.m. but close at 5:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. respectively.

Again this year, the Ocean Club will use a web-based app to assist with the pool check-in process. Members are encouraged to download the app prior to their first visit and upload a photo to help expedite the process. Additionally, guest fees will continue to apply and vary in price for non-members visiting the pool either with or without a member.
